## For Flooded Households

The Canadian Red Cross is offering flood assistance to households that have been impacted by this year's flooding. Financial assistance is available and the Red Cross will transfer the money electronically so it is immediately available to you. Initially the amount available was \$600 per household, but that may now be increased.

A single amount will be provided for all of the people living at the same address. This address must be your primary

residence. In making the request for Red Cross funds, one person should make it on behalf of all members of the household.

To receive the financial assistance, you must register with Red Cross. You can do that by calling 1-800-863-6582. You will be contacted within five to seven days.
