Just a Reminder

PARKING VIOLATION WARNING

Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards Township Parking By-Law # 02-2006

No person shall park a vehicle on any street or roadway in any street or roadway in any of the following places, except in the case of an emergency:

Part 5.9 advises "parking in any such manner as to interfere with civic or municipal services, such but not restricted to snowplowing, the removal of ice and snow or road maintenance". Part 7 advises "The Works Superintendent will be authorized to have an offending vehicle towed away during the winter months from November 1st to April 30th of each year as set out in this By-Law under part 3 – Parking Prohibited-General".


