One Student for the Visitor Information Centre:

The position will provide 30 hours per week for 10 weeks. Student must be between the ages of 16 and 24, reside in Ontario and be returning to school in the fall of 2018.

One Water Safety Assistant Instructor:

Must be at least 15 years old and possess either the Red Cross Assistant Water Safety Instructor certificate or the Lifesaving Society Assistant Instructor Certificate. Job will commence on June 29, 2018 and end August 10, 2018.

Two Students for Roads, Parks and Waste Management:

The position will provide 40 hours per week and may include weekends and holidays. Job will entail work on roads, parks and waste management sites along with recycling and organic programs. Student must possess a valid class G2 driver's licence.

One Student for Communications and Marketing:

This position will provide up to 30 hours per week for 12 weeks. The student will assist with collecting and writing content for promotional vehicles, assist with creating, organizing and executing community events and activities and manage social media campaigns. The position will require the ability to work flexible hours including weekends and holidays as required. Student must possess a valid class G2 driver's license and their own transportation.
