

**THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF KILLALOE, HAGARTY AND RICHARDS**

BY-LAW NO. 30 - 2025

Being a By-Law to authorize a Memorandum of Understanding between the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards and the Killaloe Community Resource Centre.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, Chapter 25, as amended, Section 5 (3), states that municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers, and privileges, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise; and

WHEREAS Section 8 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, Chapter 25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the authority to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and enables the municipality to respond to municipal issues; and

WHEREAS Section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, Chapter 25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers, and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act; and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and desirable that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards enact a by-law authorizing the Corporation to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Killaloe Community Resource Centre;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Memorandum of Understanding between the Killaloe Community Centre and the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards, attached hereto at Schedule "A" is hereby ratified and confirmed; and
2. THAT the Mayor and CAO/Clerk - Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to sign the Memorandum of Understanding, in substantially the same form as the Memorandum of Understanding attached hereto as Schedule "A", on behalf of the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards and all other documents as may be necessary to give effect thereto; and
3. THAT if any section or provision of this By-Law is found to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect; and
4. THAT where the provisions of any other by-law, resolution, or action of Council are inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law, the provisions of this by-law shall prevail; and
5. THAT this By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon its passing.

READ A FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED THIS 5th DAY OF AUGUST, 2025.
