

**THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF KILLALOE, HAGARTY AND RICHARDS**

**BY-LAW NO. 25 – 2026**

**Being a By-Law to appoint a Municipal By-Law Enforcement Officer and Property Standards Officer.**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 55 of the *Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019*, S.O. 2019, c. 1, Schedule 1, a municipality may appoint persons to enforce its by-laws, and such appointees are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing those by-laws of the municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 15.1 of the *Building Code Act*, S.O. 1992, Chapter 23, as amended, authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws relating to property standards;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 8 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, authorizes Councils to pass by-laws to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the Municipality's ability to respond to Municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** Part XIV of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, as amended, contains provisions regarding the enforcement of municipal By-laws;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 227 of the *Municipal Act* 2001, S.O. 2001 c.25, as amended, authorizes Councils to pass by-laws for the appointing of such officers and employees as may be necessary for the purposes of the Corporation, for carrying into effect the provisions of any by-law of the Corporation;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Brandon Bray, be appointed as Municipal Law Enforcement Officer and Property Standards Officer for the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards for so long as the person is so employed.
2. **THAT** the Municipal Law Enforcement Officer and Property Standards Officer, as appointed, shall exercise all the authority, power and rights, and shall perform all duties and obligations which by statute or by-law are or may be conferred or imposed and enforce all by-laws of The Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards and all other duties that may be imposed by Council.
3. **THAT** the Municipal By-Law Enforcement Officers' remuneration shall be set by by-law from time to time.
4. **THAT** By-Law No. 45-2025 is amended and replaced with this by-law.
5. **That** this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its passing.

READ A FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED THIS 7th DAY OF APRIL 2026.
