

**THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF KILLALOE, HAGARTY AND RICHARDS**

BY-LAW NO. 31 - 2026

Being a By-Law to Delegate Authority for Decision to the CAO/Clerk IN THE EVENT that Council finds itself subject to Section 275 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended ,regarding "Restricted Acts after Nomination Day".

WHEREAS Section 275 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c.25, as amended, limits the authority of a Council during an election year should it be determined that the new Council will include less than three-quarters of the members of the outgoing Council;

AND WHEREAS Section 23.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, authorizes a Municipality to delegate its powers and duties by By-Law;

NOW THEREFORE, Council for the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards enacts as follows:

1. That in accordance with Section 23.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, Council delegates authority for the following decisions to the CAO/Clerk in the event that Council finds itself subject to Section 275 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, regarding "Restricted Acts after Nomination Day".
 - (a) The appointment or removal from office of any officer of the Municipality;
 - (b) The hiring of/or dismissal of any employee of the Municipality;
 - (c) The disposition of any real or personal property of the Municipality which has a value exceeding \$50,000 at the time of disposal; and
 - (d) Making any expenditures or incurring any other liability which exceeds \$50,000.
2. Despite the delegation, Council is authorized to dispose of any real or personal property of the Municipality which has a value exceeding \$50,000 at the time of disposal if it was included in the most recent budget adopted by the Council before nomination day in the election.
3. Despite the delegation, Council is authorized to make any expenditures or incur any other liability which exceeds \$50,000 if it was include in the most recent budget adopted by the Council before the nomination day in the election.
4. This By-Law replaces By-Law No. 26 - 2022 and shall take effect on the date of final passing.

READ A FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED THIS 21st DAY OF APRIL 2026.
