


SPORT AND RECREATION EQUIPMENT FOR YOUR SUMMER AND FALL FUN!

Rrijoice Tie-Dyes Celebrates 25



HAPPY CLOTHES FOR HAPPY PEOPLE

25 years old and still feeling groovy, Rrijoice Tie-Dyes celebrates a quarter century of making happy clothes for happy people!

Located in Old Killaloe, owner Rri Povey has dedicated 25 years to creating unique and one-of-a-kind garments in the original Village of Killaloe. First opened in 1998, Rri originally found inspiration to open her business after deciding to embrace her creative abilities while searching for a career in her early twenties.

In 2001, she moved to Killaloe after growing up in Kitchener and Waterloo, and was drawn to the area due to its natural beauty and welcoming environment.

Being a single mother, her daughter Jasmine and son Sage, learned many valuable lessons while working with their mother, including math, while helping with counting out money.

During her free time, Rri enjoys going on walks to search for medicinal herbs and mushrooms, or tending

to her organic garden. Rri also has a large social media presence, where she displays her products and events.

Rri adds dimension and depth by using various folding techniques and dye applications; one of these methods is a hand stitching process, originating from Japan, called, Shibori, which enables images to be "tied" into the fabric.

Many of Rri's customers have been coming to her for over 20 years, and they encourage people to stop by and see her store that is located right outside her home.
