The Municipal Office is now open to the community with COVID restrictions in place. Before entering please note;

- self assessment screening must be performed before entering,
- one person in the building at a time,
- physical distancing of 2 meters, and
- mandatory mask wearing.

Access to the Municipal Office will be at the front entrance and those wishing to enter will have to buzz in at the front door and await direction from municipal staff. Physical distancing stickers/signage is posted outside. Meetings with Department Heads will be accepted by appointment only between the hours of 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday - Friday and washrooms remain closed to the public until further notice.

We are now accepting appointments for Marriage Licences. Please call the Municipal Office to schedule an appointment.

As of September 3, 2020, interest will be charged on all current and prior arrears on utilities and property tax accounts. The next final property tax billing and utility billing payments are due on October 30, 2020.

We now accept **e-transfers** as a method of making payments to the municipality and continue to accept online/telephone banking, Interac, cash and cheques. When making an e-transfer payment, please include all necessary information (name, account numbers, what the payment is for, etc.) and email to **info@khrtownship.ca** Payments can also be placed in the "**Municipal Drop Box**" which is now located at the front entrance of the municipal building.

Council will continue to meet via ZOOM for meetings until further notice. The next scheduled meetings are September 29, 2020 at 7:00 pm and October 20, 2020 at 7:00 pm. Please check our website for meeting dates at www.killaloe-hagarty-richards.ca

Any questions or concerns for council's attention can be submitted to the CAO/Clerk Treasurer in writing five (5) days prior to meeting dates so they can be included in council packages. Agendas will now be made available on our website and Facebook page.

Waste recovery sites are open as per regular scheduled hours and are now accepting cash, however the "Second Chance" building will remain **closed** until further notice. Garbage stickers are now required and they can be purchased at the Municipal Office and waste recovery sites.

Please know that your safety, the community's safety and the safety of our employees remains our top priority. We appreciate your co-operation and understanding as we work together to limit the spread of COVID-19 in our community.
