Notice of Intention to Pass a By-law to Submit a Question to Electors

Take notice that Council of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards intends to consider and pass a by-law under the authority of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* to submit two questions to the electors for the 2026 municipal election.

In accordance with the statutory requirement to provide notice to the public and to the Minister not fewer than ten (10) days prior to passage of the by-law, notice is hereby given that Council will consider the proposed by-law at its meeting scheduled for:

Date: January 21, 2026 (changed from January 20, 2026)

Time: 7:00 pm Local Time

Location: 1 John Street, Killaloe ON

The purpose of the proposed by-law is to submit the following questions to the electors:

1. "Are you in favour of abolishing the current ward system in the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards?"
2. "Are you in favour of reducing the size of Council to four (4) Councillors and one (1) Mayor for the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards?"

The by-law, once enacted, would authorize the placement of this question on the ballot for the next regular municipal election, subject to all applicable legislative requirements.
