

KHR SORTING GUIDE

BLUE BOX

Paper/Fibre Recycling

- Cardboard; Shoe boxes, mail boxes, pizza boxes, moving boxes
- Boxboard; Cereal boxes, tissue boxes, cookie/cracker boxes, toilet/paper towel rolls, cardboard egg cartons
- Paper; Office mixed paper, newspapers, flyers, magazines, catalogues, writing paper, flour/prescription bags, file folders, cards/envelopes
- Paper Laminate; Brown paper bags, dog/cat kraft bags, food service bags, ice cream containers, hot/cold beverage cups, spiral cans, paper plates
- Cartons; Milk and juice cartons/boxes, cream/sugar cartons, soup/sauce cartons and beverage cartons
- Plastic Packaging; Bags, overwrap, chip/coffee bags, deli pouches, bubble wrap, snack wrappers, cereal bags, gift bags



Commingled Container Recycling

- Plastics; Laundry/cleaning jugs, water/beverage/condiment bottles, food trays, yogurt/food containers, cups/tubs/lids, toothpaste/cream tubes, pots
- Foam Packaging; Meat trays, takeout containers, cups/plates/bowls
- Metal; Food cans, lids, cookie/coffee/tea tins, beverage cans
- Aluminum; Foil, trays, pie plates
- Aerosol (Empty); Food/air/hair spray, shaving/deodorant cans
- Glass; Clear/colored glass, food containers, jars/bottles, spice bottles, cosmetic containers, oil/vinegar bottles, non-alcoholic beverage bottles

Please continue to sort your recyclables at the source for curbside pick-up, as well as for processing at the waste sites. Paper/Fibre can be recycled together. Commingled Containers can be recycled together.

ORGANICS

- All kitchen waste & food scraps
- Cooking oils, grease, fat (solid)
- Soiled pizza boxes
- Meat, chicken, fish, bones
- Fruit & vegetable peelings, egg & nut shells
- Bread, rice, pasta, dairy products
- Microwave popcorn bags
- Waxed corrugated cardboard
- Paper coffee & cold drink cups (without lids & straws)
- Coffee grounds & filters, tea bags, muffin liners
- Soiled paper items (napkins tissues, towels, etc.)

IMPORTANT

No plastics of any kind (including plastic bags claiming to be biodegradable or compostable), plastic wrap, diapers, kitty litter, pet waste, ashes, dryer lint, metals or glass of any kind are permitted with the organics.

- Christmas tree lights
- Clothesline
- Corks
- Crayons
- Dialysis tubing
- Diapers & diaper wipes
- Dishes
- Disposable mop sheets
- Dryer sheets & lint
- Feminine hygiene products
- Florist foam
- Mirrors
- Photographs
- Plastic cutlery
- Pool noodles
- Rags & unusable clothing
- Rope
- Toys

.....plus other household waste that is not included in the blue box, organics, electronic or hazardous waste lists



ELECTRONIC WASTE

- Amplifiers, speakers, receivers
- Cameras
- Cell Phones
- Computers & peripherals
- Copiers, fax machines
- Radios
- Televisions
- Telephones & answering machines



These items are accepted and can be taken to the Mask Road Waste Disposal Site year round.

ACCEPTED

- Car and Automotive Batteries
- Regular Batteries (Alkaline/Lithium)
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Empty Paint Cans
- Empty Automotive Containers
- Smoke/Carbon Monoxide Detectors

These items are accepted and can be taken to the Mask Road Waste Disposal Site year round.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

- Motor Oil/Automotive Fluids
- Light Bulbs (Fluorescent/CFL)
- Propane Tanks/Cylinders
- Acids
- Glue/Varnish Finishing Products
- Drain & Oven Cleaners
- Bleach
- Pharmaceuticals
- Antifreeze
- Cleaning Fluids
- Paint (Latex/Oil)
- Caustics (Iye)
- Gasoline
- Pool Chemicals
- Pesticides/Herbicides/Insecticides
- Ammonia
- Aerosol Cans/Solvents (not empty)



These items are not accepted at any of the Waste Disposal Sites, however they can be disposed of safely at the annual HHW day.

NOT ACCEPTED

- Lancets (sharps)
- PBC's (Polychlorinated Biphenyls)
- Pathological Waste
- Radioactive Material
- Needles and Syringes
- Nickel-Cadmium Batteries

These items are not accepted at any of the Waste Disposal Sites or HHW day.
