Council for the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards met on the above date with Mayor David Mayville and Councillors Harold Lavigne, Bil Smith, Maureen MacMillan, Carl Kuehl, Ted Browne and Brian Pecoskie in attendance.

**Call to Order:**

Mayor Mayville chaired the meeting which he opened and called to order.

**Mayor's Address:**

Mayor Mayville read a prepared statement addressing his decision not to pursue a judicial review regarding the sanctions imposed on him, and his request that Council donate an amount equal to his remuneration to local service clubs or community organizations of his choosing.

Mayor Mayville provided an update on recent events he attended representing the Township, specifically; a Water/Wastewater Review Committee meeting, an Irish Gathering meeting, a Committee of the Whole meeting and a County Council meeting including Committees of Health, Corporate Services and Community Services as well as a final budget meeting.

Mayor Mayville expressed gratitude to the Public Works Department for their dedication and efforts throughout the recent winter events.

**Delegations:**

Brian Whiffin President of the Killaloe and Area Pickleball was in attendance and invited to address Council. Mr. Whiffin presented a proposal on a Killaloe Rink Surface Improvement project aimed at improving the facility's versatility to support the sport of Pickleball.

Council considered the proposal and asked that staff conduct a review and prepare a report.

Council thanked Mr. Whiffin for his presentation at which time he left the meeting.

Auditor Wil Barr was present and invited to address Council. Mr. Barr presented the Financial Audited Statements. Council reviewed the Audited Financial Statements with Mr. Barr and posed questions, to which Mr. Barr addressed.

Mr. Barr advised that the OCIF/Gas Tax revenues do not result in overcompensation on the revenue side of the provisional budget. Mr. Barr also reiterated the explanation of how water and wastewater revenues and expenditures balance in the provisional budget.
