Call to Order:

Mayor Dave Mayville chaired the meeting, which he opened and called to order.

Pecuniary/Financial Interest:

No pecuniary/financial interest was declared by any of the Council members present.

Purpose of the Meeting:

The Municipality has initiated a proposed Housekeeping Zoning By-Law Amendment to make minor technical and administrative updates to the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards Zoning By-Law, including but not limited to:

- Correction of spelling, grammar and typos,
- Addition or removal of uses and provisions to provide clarity,
- Updates to definitions and general provisions,
- Updating references to legislation or other municipal documents, and
- Updates to mapping and schedules.

All other provisions of the Zoning By-Law shall apply.

Appeal to OMP – Planning Act:

Section 34(11) - If Council decides to refuse an application or refuses or neglects to make a decision on an application within 120 days of the municipal clerk receiving the application, the applicant or the Minister of Municipal Affairs, may appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal by filing an appeal with the clerk of the municipality.

Section 34(19) – Not later than 20 days after the giving of notice of passing of the by-law, the applicant, any person or public body who made oral submissions at the public meeting or made a written submission to Council, before the by-law was passed, or the Minister of Municipal Affairs, may appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal by filing an appeal with the clerk of the municipality.

Correspondence:

The Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards received Agency Responses from Ottawa River Power, Renfrew Power Generation and Bonnechere Valley Township to which no comments or concerns were identified.

Delegations:

Members of the public provided comments, and asked questions of Council to which Council responded.

As no other correspondence or objection had been received, Council approved the proposed zoning amendment.
