

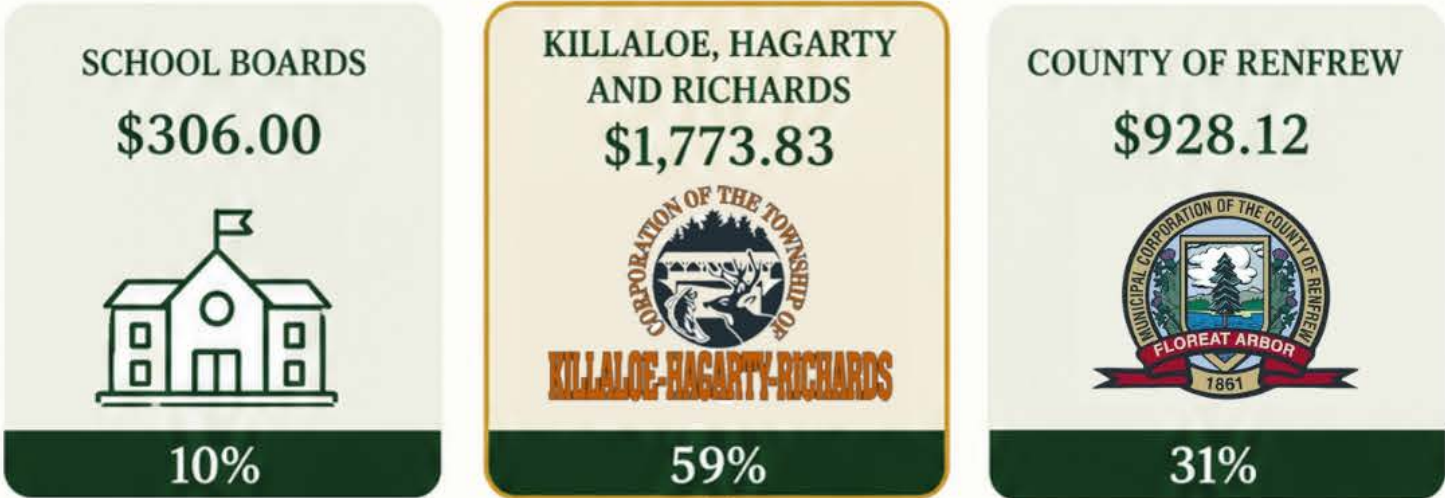

WASTE INFORMATION

Household Hazardous Waste Day

Saturday October 3rd 2026

9:00 am to 3:00 pm

Each year, the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards hosts its annual Household Hazardous Waste Day. Every year, we receive hundreds of items that residents have stored throughout the year that could have been disposed of at the Township's Killaloe Waste Disposal Site during regular operating hours. Many recyclable materials and household items can be dropped off year-round at the Waste Disposal Site, helping you safely dispose of them without waiting for the annual event.



NOT ACCEPTED AT ANY WASTE DISPOSAL SITE OR HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY:

- Lancets (sharps)
- PBC's (Polychlorinated Biphenyls)
- Pathological Waste
- Radioactive Material
- Needles and Syringes
- Nickel-Cadmium Batteries

Here is a quick guide to some of the items accepted at the Killaloe Waste Disposal Site (only) and Household Hazardous Waste Day:

Accepted Year Round At 1049 Mask Road Waste Site:

- Car and Automotive Batteries
- Household Batteries (Alkaline/Lithium)
- Empty Aerosol Cans (Alkaline & Lithium)
- Empty Paint Cans (Paint, Stain, Finish)
- Empty Automotive Containers (Oil, Fluids)
- Smoke/Carbon Monoxide Detectors
- Electronic Waste:
 - Amplifiers, speakers, receivers
 - Cameras
 - Cell Phones
 - Computers & peripherals
 - Copiers, fax machines
 - Radios
 - Televisions
 - Telephones & answering machines



Accepted At Household Hazardous Waste Day:

- Motor Oil/Automotive Fluids
- Light Bulbs (Fluorescent/CFL)
- Propane Tanks/Cylinders
- Acids
- Glue/Varnish Finishing Products
- Drain & Oven Cleaners
- Bleach
- Pharmaceuticals
- Antifreeze
- Cleaning Fluids
- Paint (Latex/Oil)
- Caustics (lye)
- Gasoline
- Pool Chemicals
- Pesticides/Herbicides/Insecticides
- Ammonia
- Aerosol Cans/Solvents (not empty)

MUNICIPAL ELECTION OCTOBER 26, 2026



Municipal elections provide residents with the opportunity to help shape the future of our community by electing a Mayor and Council. Voting is an important way to have your voice heard on local issues that affect everyday life, including roads, parks, recreation, infrastructure, and community services.

In addition to electing members of Council, the 2026 Municipal Election ballot will include the following two questions:

1. Are you in favour of abolishing the current ward system in the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards?
2. Are you in favour of reducing the size of Council to four (4) Councillors and one (1) Mayor for the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards?



Residents are encouraged to learn more about these questions before voting. Information regarding frequently asked questions and the advantages and disadvantages of Council composition, the current ward system, and the Strong Mayor Powers as they relate to Council composition, is available on the Township's website.



Eligible voters are encouraged to ensure they are registered to vote and to watch for election information, including key dates, candidate information, voting locations, and Vote by Mail instructions.



NEW FEES AND CHARGES

The Township has updated its Fees and Charges By-law No. 43 - 2026. Whether you're applying for a permit, requesting a municipal service, purchasing a licence, or using Township facilities, we encourage you to review the current schedule of fees before submitting your application or request.
